This was among the matters shared by the Minister of Education during a Forum on the current policy of the 48th South East Asian Ministers of Education Organisation Council, SEAMEO Council Conference in Chonburi, Thailand.

The conference was attended by Yang Berhormat Pehin Orang Kaya Seri Kerna Dato Seri Setia Doktor Awang Haji Abu Bakar bin Haji Apong, the Minister of Education. During the conference, the Council approved the application of the China Education Association for International Exchange, CEAIE for affiliate membership. Also attending the conference were Ministers of Education from Malaysia, Indonesia, Singapore and Timor Leste, as well as Deputy Minister from Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar and the Philippines. Also featured in the conference was the Ministerial Round-table Meeting. The 49th SEAMEO Conference will be held in Indonesia in 2017. Also joining the Brunei Darussalam delegation at the conference was Doctor Haji Junaidi bin Haji Abd Rahman, Permanent Secretary for Core Education at the Ministry of Education.
