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Carol Benson has worked in educational development since the 1980s, when she was a volunteer teacher trainer with the United States Peace Corps in Sierra Leone. She holds a Ph.D in Social Sciences and Comparative Education from the University of California, Los Angeles and currently works in teacher professional development at Stockholm University. She is also a consultant in mother tongue-based multilingual education in the Americas, Europe and Africa, including Guinea-Bissau, Mozambique, South Africa and Ethiopia. Recently she has been working in Vietnam with the Ministry of Education and Training and UNICEF to design and pilot bilingual schooling in three minority languages and Vietnamese. She is also actively engaged in research relating to mother tongue-based schooling, the influence of language competence on learning across the curriculum and the ways that mother tongue education might facilitate girls' education.
