# PART II: Information about the School's Activity/Programme on Education for **Disaster Risk Reduction**

1. Title of the school's activity/programme on Education for Disaster Risk Reduction

Kelompok Siaga Bencana Sekolah (KSBS) SMA Pertiwi 1 Padang

2. Summary of the activity/programme

Disaster Preparedness Programme at SMA Pertiwi 1 that started in 2008 was facilitated by Tsunami Alert Community Foundation (KOGAMI) which supported by UNESCO and ISDR. The goal is to increase the school capacity in disaster preparedness and to perform a trial for the implementation of curriculum with local content in disaster preparedness.

The school capacity building in disaster preparedness was carried out through several activities such as:

- 1. Preparation and preliminary assessment.
- 2. Teacher capacity building.
- 3. Student capacity building.
- 4. Formatting the School Disaster Alert Group (Kelompok Siaga Bencana Sekolah) (KSBS)
- 5. Designing the School Disaster Preparedness System
- 6. Evacuation Drill
- 7. Final Assessment

The implementation of disaster preparedness curriculum was conducted within activities, for instance :

- 1. The design of Local content curriculum in disaster preparedness draft
- 2. The formation of Study Subject Teacher Council in disaster preparedness
- 3. Public socialization and consultation of local content curriculum in disaster preparedness
- 4. The implementation of local content curriculum in disaster preparedness
- 5. Evaluation

After the program accomplished, the school abides the preparedness activity through some policies which support the disaster risk reduction attempt, for example :

- To make KSBS as one of extracurricular activities.
  The KSBS continues to build the capacity of its members by conducting routine training on preparedness and emergency quick response with relevant institution/organization. Besides that, the commitment in regeneration process has led the KSBS to exist until now.
- To implement the local content curriculum in disaster preparedness
  The local content curriculum in disaster preparedness has been implemented since 2008 until present. Today, the local content curriculum in disaster preparedness has been included in District Regulation (Peraturan Daerah (Perda)) No 5 year 2011 about education execution in Padang City.
- Together with schools and other organizations carry out routine advocacy activities to the government to implement the curriculum shortly, with the intention that if the disaster happens then the effect can be minimalize.
- To perform routine evacuation drill
- To be involve actively in many disaster emergency quick response, especially in Padang City and generally in West Sumatra.
- To be involve in recording and in delivering the aids for the survivor.
- To be involve in trauma healing in disaster area.

Currently, the SMA Pertiwi 1 Padang has become the reference for other schools in West Sumatra Province and Indonesia as the presentation of disaster-prepared school.

3. Background information or reasons why the school initiated this activity/programme

Since 2005, West Sumatra, especially Padang City has become the center of attention for its high susceptibility on tsunami disaster threat because of possible energy release in subduction zone. 8,9 SR earthquake was predicted to trigger the tsunami with 10 m height above sea level. (Kerry

Sieh dan Danny Hilman, 2011). For having a high density of population in the coastal area has putted Padang City as the city with the highest risk of tsunami hazard in the world. (National Geographic, 2005).

Some experiences on earthquake strike with tsunami warning have led the school community to panic situation for not knowing what to do. The situation even brought victim from the student who jumped off the second floor to rescue himself when the quake stroke.

Based on the information and previous experiences, the school accepted the programme that offer by Tsunami Alert Community Foundation (Yayasan Komunitas Siaga Tsunami) (KOGAMI) which supported by Unesco and ISDR, to make SMA Pertiwi 1 as a pilot school for disaster preparedness in Padang City. Since 2008, the school has persistently improved the preparedness throughout the school. Namely, the arrangement of disaster management system like standard procedure for school disaster management, the formation of School Disaster Alert Group (kelompok siaga bencana sekolah (KSBS), the implementation of local content curriculum in disaster preparedness, and evacuation drills which performed routinely and constantly.

Within those activities, throughout the school already aware of the danger potential in school area. They also discern how to rescue themselves when the disaster hit without panic and know the evacuation route if the evacuation must be made. Next, the hope is for whole components of SMA Pertiwi 1 Padang can spread the disaster alertness, so that many lives can be saved when the disaster hit again.

- a. To extend the humanity value and act.
- b. To develop the understanding about disaster risks, social and physical vulnerability, also the susceptibility of action and motivation.
- c. To enhance the knowledge and skills to prevent and to decrease the disaster risk, to strengthen the responsible human and environment resource management, and, to improve the adaptation to disaster risks.

- Interview with school groups and community around the school.
- Focused Group Discussion with KSBS and school party

10. Benefits/impacts of the activity/programme to teachers, students and the community

- a. The school disaster preparedness improved
- b. The panic situation during disaster reduced significantly
- c. The learning process ran well. When the quake hit, the learning process continued if the evacuation, based on the standard procedure, was not required. Meanwhile, other schools that has no standard procedure for disaster will take the school activities off.
- d. The parents were confident for the safety of their offspring in SMA Pertiwi 1 Padang. The fact is many school along the coast faced the recruitment reduction both state school and private school, while SMA Pertiwi 1 must provide the additional classes from 8 to 10 classes because the interest increased highly.
- e. The community around the school made the school as the parameter to perform evacuation. If during the disaster the school continued the learning process and stayed calm, then the community will do the same. And vice versa, if the school took the evacuation process, then the community will respond in the same way.
- f. The KSBS, disaster-concern scout and teenage-red cross were actively involved by other institutions/organizations work on disaster-management in many disaster-related activities, before, after even during the disaster.
- g. KSBS SMA Pertiwi 1 Padang became the reference and school-prepared disaster laboratory

for West Sumatra Province and Indonesia. It has been shown from the visit from both domestic and foreign country that interested to observe the school preparedness themselves.

11. Plan for sustainability and plan for the future

Plan for sustainability:

- a. To fix and to improve the school disaster management system based on recent information and data to maintain update.
- b. To socialize the existing system routinely throughout the school, in order to ensure either the headmaster replacement or other changes will not affect the system.
- c. To conduct KSBS regeneration each year.
- d. To implement disaster preparedness into local content curriculum

Plan for the future:

- a. To achieve the utilization of all school components in disaster risk reduction effort and to build the safe and strong culture toward disaster threat. Recently, KSBS, teenage-red cross and disaster-concerned scout have became first line guard for school disaster management.
- b. To be a well-prepared school toward upcoming disaster.
- c. To perform a united-training with all KSBS in West Sumatra Province, in order to pass on the disaster-preparedness culture.
