Dear Mr Gorica,

I refer to your letter of 2 November 1983, requesting SEAMEO to consider ACCC for SEAMEO Affiliate Membership.

In this connection I have the pleasure to inform you that the Council discussed the matter at its last Conference held in Pattaya, Thailand, February 1984, and approved the application from the Association of Canadian Community Colleges for SEAMEO Affiliate Membership.

The Council at the same Conference also determined that Affiliate Member's annual contribution be in the amount of US\$ 5,000, and that the utilization of these contributions be in accordance with the guidelines for the utilization of Associate Members' annual contributions, to be applied *mutatis mutandis*.

These guidelines were approved by the Council at an earlier Conference, namely the 18th SEAMEC Conference, 1983. They read as follows:

- 1) To cover additional expenses arising from liaison work with Associate Members;
- 2) To meet the costs of certain unbudgeted activities for which, normally, special grants are sought by the Secretariat;
- 3) To supplement the costs of promotional activities such as fund-raising and publications.

In addition the Council at its 18th SEAMEC Conference also approved the following two new guidelines:


4) To support specific regular programmes and activities of Centres and Projects for which Special Funds are not available or adequate;

5) To support special programmes or activities of the organization, subject to prior acceptance of the Associate Members.

It is my sincere hope that the amount stipulated as Affiliate Member's annual contribution will not stand in our way, so we can proceed with our efforts, which have already made a significant start, to work out programmes of cooperation between ACCC and SEAMEO.

Your reply to this letter, confirming ACCC's acceptance of the terms and conditions of SEAMEO Affiliate Membership and the stipulated Affiliate Member's annual contribution, will constitute the consummation of the status of ACCC as Affiliate Member of SEAMEO.

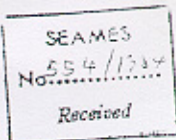
