RATIONALE: Being alert and being prepared, the key to disaster survival.

Due to its location in the map, our country is very prone to all natural hazards. It is expected that at any time, any of the natural forces would hit the country. Hence all individuals shall always be alert and be prepared. Being on this state it would lessen the number of victims and would save more lives.

Children are the most vulnerable victims. Thus they must be given attention and be educated. Giving them roles and responsibility in the disaster plan will help lessen the problems and may also resolve in any manner. Children would become capable of doing good acts of survival which in turn would benefit their community.

Curriculum. Disaster Education shall be integrated in the curriculum through interdisciplinary approach. There will be one disaster theme to be taken up across all subjects. This approach make the learners think globally in nature. It will make the learners relate the theme to all disciplines. This further strengthens the learning power of interrelatedness.

Co-curricular Activities. To strengthen the disaster awareness and to enhance skills among learners, meaningful and interactive activities are prepared to complement the formal lessons in the classrooms. This includes practical exercises such as drills, workshops and trainings and creative works such as drawing, poster making, flyer making, role playing, poem writing, poem delivery and simple research. Doing hands-on activities will deepen their understanding and from this they will develop good attitude and behavior.
