

## HISTORY OF SMK IBRAHIM

Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan Ibrahim was established in August 1919, as one of the Government's English School in the country. It's original site is located at the present Telecoms Office in Sungai Petani. At the beginning of its establishment, the school was led by only two teachers, an assistant teacher and the late Tuan Syed Jan Al-Jefree as the principal.

In 1935, the school was relocated to the present 30.29 hectare site. The new premise was officiated by the Education Director of Kedah at the time, En. La. M. Stowell, and was named Sultan Abdul Hamid School.

In 1936, the school was once again renamed as Sekolah Menengah Ibrahim (Ibrahim Secondary School) in accordance with the late H.R.H. Tengku Ibrahim Ibni Sultan Hamid Shah, who was the Acting Sultan from 1913 to 1914. During the Second World War, Sekolah Menengah Ibrahim had to be closed down to make way for the Japanese Military base but was reopened in October 1945, after the Second World War and has ever since become 'the apple of the eye' of the school community.
