The school was opened in 1978 to cater for the sixth formers and was formerly known as Junior Science Since then, Kolej Datu Patinggi Abang Haji Abdillah has moved forward with College. tremendous accomplishment not only in academic performance but also stellar achievements in extra-curricular activities. It was awarded the Cluster Excellence School title in 2008 and the niche areas are English language (Academic), Rugby (Sports) and ICT. Kolej Datu Patinggi Abang Haji Abdillah has confirmed its status as Sarawak's best school in the Day School Category as it obtained 2.22 of the School Grade Point Average (GPS) in the SPM results 2011 and ranked third in the overall category. Students' great achievement in the extra-curricular aspects is also a source of pride to the school. 3 rugby players of the school represented Malaysia in the Zahira 7s International Invitation, Colombo, Sri Lanka and the school is currently the 3rd runner-up winner of the '10s COBRA U16 International Invitation 2012'. One of the most active clubs in the school is the Environment Club (PALS). Its Eco-band participated and performed alongside international artistes in the Rainforest Music Festival using reusable items as its musical instruments. Facilities wise, the school boasts of having 202 computers, with two Computer Kiosks accessible to students during and after school hours.
