2. Summary of the programme (one half to 1 page of A4 sheet size)

The 17 th Boarding School Culture is one of SMP Darul Ulum 1 Peterongan program that conducted by stakeholders cooperate with SBP (School Based on Boarding School) from Ministry of Education in Indonesia. The main purposes of this program are building peace in the school and communities and also support Sustainable Development Goals. This program including 17 Islamic Boarding characters building consist of The 17 Islamic boarding school cultures are 1. The deepening of religious knowledge, 2. Boarding House / stay in Islamic Boarding School, 3. Obedience, 4. Exemplary, 5. Piety, 6. Independence, 7. Discipline, 8. Simplicity, 9. Tolerance, 10. Sincerity, 11. Humble, 12. Patience, 13. Solidarity, 14. Heartiness, 15. Consistence, 16. Social, 17. Cleanliness. All cultures/characters must be implemented by the students, staffs and teachers.
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SMP Darul Ulum 1 Peterongan has 1008 students that they are from many regions in Indonesia, such as Madura, Surabaya, Jombang, Jakarta, Medan, Nusa Tenggara Timur, Kalimantan and Papua etc. They live in boarding houses of Darul Ulum Islamic Boarding School/Pondok Pesantren Darul Ulum Jombang. Besides, Pondok Pesantren Darul Ulum Jombang has 12 schools and ± 10,000 students. One of the schools in Pondok Pesantren Darul Ulum is SMP Darul Ulum Peterongan.

SMP Darul Ulum 1 Peterongan students study at school from 07.00 a.m to 04.00 p.m. To implement the 17th Islamic Boarding School Cultures in school, the school has done such as:

1. **Students must like their teachers first before like the lesson.** They must know their teachers' characters as far as themselves. They must obey their teachers.
2. **In queue, before enter the school gate, the students must shake hands and kiss teachers' hand, and shake hands with their friends.**
3. **Lunch together.** They students pray before and after lunch, have lunch with same meal.
4. **Never avoid or refuse the guest.** Australian Teachers visited this school in 2012 and 2013 (Ms. Cindy Godwin, Kelly Kenworthy from BRIDGE Program). The school also had foreign teachers from KOICA Program - South Korea, (Ms. Kwak Eun Hye, 2012 – 2013, and Ms. Choi Mi Kyung, 2015 – 2017, they teach Computer and from Peace corps program - USA, Mr. Tyler Beltz, 2015 – 2017. He teaches English)
5. **Never differentiate ethnic.** So, the students who are from different region can join in the same class.
6. **Share happiness with citizen near the school.** In Fasting month/Ramadhan, the school gave rice and money to the poor people.

Besides, SMP Darul Ulum 1 Peterongan includes Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics/STEM program in studying and learning. Here, we integrate STEM program and The 17th characters based on Islamic boarding school cultures to build peaceful school and also to obtain SDGs.

SMP Darul Ulum 1 Peterongan as one of the leading schools supported by sufficient resources, has a vision and mission, one of which is superior in the field of science and technology mastery has the potential to make one of its advantages focus on integrating the development of ability in technology and 21st century skills through a STEM-Based Superior Class Program with how to facilitate students with great interest and potential towards the character of STEM development so that it is hoped that the interest and potential will continue and will continue to develop into senior high school and universities.

Science and Technology (Science and Technology) continues to grow rapidly. Towards the Industrial Era 4.0, increasingly complex challenges and competitions require attention to the preparation of human resources early on, especially through the world of education. The purpose of learning, students are not expected to master knowledge only (content oriented) but more than that knowledge must be very contextual to integrate technological themes early on by involving higher-order thinking skills (HOTS). Therefore STEM-based education is one of the strategies in priority programs from various countries including SEAMEO's "Adopting 21st Curriculum" program in developing 21st century skills through training activities, competitions, conferences and networking.
