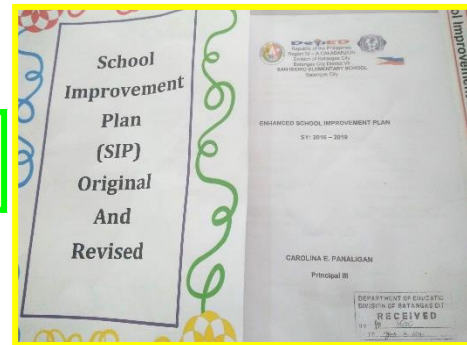


Clear articulation and integration of social, ethical, environment and climate change dimensions in the institution's vision, mission and governance


Some Implemented Rules and Regulations

School Policies on Environmental Awareness

1. Use natural ventilation whenever possible.
 - Turn on electric fans only from 10:30-12:00 and 1:00-3:00 PM.
2. Use energy savers bulb instead of incandescent bulbs.
3. Turn on lights only when needed.
4. Report leaks promptly.
5. Use water from artesian well in watering plants in the morning. Use the well also in washing rags, curtains etc.
6. Do not throw used papers. Put them in the paper boxes which can be found in every classroom.

The school's policy is communicated to the school populace during PTA General Assembly, Stakeholder's Day and other forums in school. Likewise teachers and school heads constantly remind pupils of these rules and regulations inside the classroom during class hours.

This project will focus on maintaining Zero Plastic and Zero Paper On the School and Barangay Community Grounds. Science club will be in charge of this project. As such, the following guidelines shall be observed:

1. Pupils are required to bring their own small plastic bag on their pockets to keep their plastic garbage there.
2. Plastic garbage shall be disposed NOT in our school garbage pit but on their own garbage pit at home.
3. Only biodegradable trash shall be disposed to school's garbage pit.
4. Recyclable materials will be stored in our MRF and later be sold. Top 3 sections with highest sales at the end of school year shall be recognized.
5. EPP, Science, HEKASI, Boy and Girl Scouts, Pupil Government officers shall lead in the implementation of the project especially in adopting a street in the Barangay and shall maintain its cleanliness and sustainability
6. Maintenance of the vegetable garden shall be in full operation so everybody is invited to support it.
