2. Summary of the initiative (a half page of A4)

June 1, 2021 we had our School Planning and Review on the Annual Improvement Plan (AIP) for the

2<sup>nd</sup> Semester from July to December 2021 and made an alignment of the Work and Financial Plan (WFP) for July to December 2020 in order that what is needed during the pandemic was in the AIP and WFP. July 26, 2020 General PTA Meeting was held in the school ground for the Brigada Eskwela (BE) to prepare the School for the opening of classes and collection of distributed Learners Enrollment School Forms (LESF), analyzed and made some changes in our School Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP). All the projects implemented under BE benefited the learners, teachers, parents and the community as well. We garnered champion in the district and participated in the Division Level. For the preparation and readiness of the teachers several staff meetings and LAC sessions were conducted. September 21, 2020 was the first orientation of the parents and other stakeholders wherein issues and concerns were tackled and were able to provide possible solutions that is the Project SIGLAT (School Interventions in Guiding Learners and Assisting them Totally) wherein we tap 2 volunteers parents per purok as our para teachers and we included in our class program 1 day within the week as the schedule of teachers to conduct home visit to the purok where they were assigned but in times of failure to conduct home visitation due to hectic schedules, teachers monitors the learners through monitoring the para teachers. October 1, 2020 was the second orientation before the learners' materials and self-learning modules were distributed to the parents. On October 5, 2020 all the teachers went around to the sitio were they assigned and conducted monitoring to learners and parents. Under this Project SIGLAT are the other support school programs/projects like Project REaDal ( Reading Enhancement and Development Among Learners), Project ELSE (Enhance Learners Skills in English), Project NIMFA (Nurturing learners with Integrated Math Festivities and Activities) or Project KUMUSTAHAN, Project AID (Addressing Individual Differences), Project ERAP (Eradicate Repetition Among Pupils), Project HELE (Happy Environment for Learners and Educators), Project IDETS (Integration of Drug Education in Teaching some Subject Area), Project SHARE (Sharing Blessings to Learners and Hand-in-Hand in Giving Assistance Materially to Realize Education Goals Amidst Pandemic), Project AGINS (Achieving Goals in Improving Nutritional Status), Project PANDeMIC (Promote Attainable Nutrition, Dental and Medical Issues Consciousness), Project GREEN (Green Resources in Environment that Enhance Nutrition) Project TRAIN (Train the teachers to Regain and Acquire Information's Needed in Teaching), Project IMPART (Improved Mass Participation and Active Response of Teachers in provision of contextualized materials using ICT), Project MAPP (Mass Active Participation in all Programs /Projects of the School) and Project ISUS PAD (Initiate Stakeholders to Uphold School Projects and Activities for Continuous **D**evelopment).

  - ➢ Give assistance to learners especially learners without knowledgeable elders to assist them;
  - > Improve learning achievement of learners in this modular mode of learning.
  - Eradicate repetition among pupils
- 4. Period of the time when the initiative was/has been startedAll the Project/Programs were implemented last June 2020 to July 2021
- 5. Activities (strategies/activities of implementation, and brief information of each activity)
- 1) Project SIGLAT –to give school interventions in guiding learners and assisting them totally we tapped volunteers as para teachers especially the parents to include to teach their relatives or neighborhood without assistors at least 2 hours daily not exceeding from 5 number of learners. Gathering 5 learners in a long table, para teachers were oriented to let the learners always observe health protocols. Also teachers visited the learners weekly or twice a month during rainy days especially the time that the community is a free from COVID Cases since April 2020 until April 2021.
- 2) Project REaDal in reading enhancement and development among learners, the teachers conducted home visitation, they let the learners read to identify their reading level and gave interventions to learners who were under frustration level especially based from the English and Filipino PHIL-IRI Report.
- 3) Project ELSE-To Enhance Learners Skills in English teachers brought with them reading materials and let the learners read and borrow the instructional materials.
- 4) Project KUMUSTAHAN and Project NIMFA in Nurturing learners with Integrated Math Festivities and Activities, teachers visited the learners and gave interventions especially those who are non-numerates and gave some instructional materials for the learners to use

- 5) Project AID In Addressing Individual Differences, teachers considered the ability of every child. Those who cannot answer all the activities in the modules, answer sheet were provided wherein 2 activities were given for each objective in the Most Essential Learning Competencies. Even teachers in having differences from each other, trainings and workshops were proposed and conducted to address the Individual Developmental Needs that was submitted based in their IPCRF.
- 6) Project IDETS- Integration of Drug Education in Teaching some Subject Area was included in the Learning Activity Sheet (LAS) that were given to the learners through their parents. Even during PTA Meetings and orientation of the Barangay health workers, mid-wife and Nurses Drug Education were included in the agenda.
- 7) Project AGINS-in Achieving Goals in Improving Nutritional Status especially kindergarten and wasted learners, names were submitted to Division Office and were allotted fund for the School Feeding Program which was implemented by the school.
- 8) Project PANDeMIC- in Promoting Attainable Nutrition, Dental and Medical Issues Consciousness, we tapped our health workers in the barangay including the Municipal nurses. They were able to come and educate our parents.
- 9) Project SHARE –in Sharing Blessings to Learners and Hand-in-Hand in Giving Assistance Materially to Realize Education Goals Amidst Pandemic to the learners we solicited donor who donated school supplies, slippers and clothing to learners and umbrella to parents
- 6. Teaching and learning approaches/strategies that the school has integrated for this school initiative
- 1. Project IMPART- Improved Mass Participation and Active Response of Teachers in provision of contextualized materials using ICT, we proposed a School Learning Action Cell and Implemented it.
- 2. Project SIGLAT –to give school interventions in guiding learners and assisting them totally, we tapped volunteers as para teachers especially the parents. Teachers visited the learners weekly or twice a month during rainy days especially the time that the community is a free from COVID Cases since April 2020 until April 2021.
- 3. Project REaDal in reading enhancement and development among learners, the teachers conducted home visitation, let the learners read to identify their reading level and gave interventions especially to learners who were under frustration level based from the English and Filipino PHIL-IRI Report.
- 4. Project ELSE-To Enhance Learners Skills in English teachers brought with them reading materials and let the learners read and borrow the instructional materials.
- 5. Project KUMUSTAHAN and Project NIMFA in Nurturing learners with Integrated Math Festivities and Activities, teachers visited the learners and gave interventions especially those who are non-numerates and gave some instructional materials for the learners to use

- 7. Participation of community and parents in the school initiative
- 1. Project SIGLAT –to give school interventions in guiding learners and assisting them totally we tapped volunteers as para teachers especially the parents to include to teach their relatives or neighborhood without assistors at least 2 hours daily not exceeding from 5 number of learners.
- 2. Project REaDal and ELSE– in reading enhancement and development among learners, parents help their child to continue read the instructional materials given by the teachers
- 3. Project KUMUSTAHAN and Project NIMFA in nurturing learners with Integrated Math Festivities and Activities, parents let their child/ren use the instructional materials given by the teachers.
- 4. Project IDETS- Integration of Drug Education in Teaching some Subject Area even during PTA Meetings and orientations we tapped Barangay health workers, mid-wife and Nurses as speakers.
- 5. Project AGINS-in Achieving Goals in Improving Nutritional Status especially kindergarten and wasted learners, parents are responsible in giving the foods taken in school and monitor that their child/ren

will eat/drink

- 6. Project PANDeMIC- in Promoting Attainable Nutrition, Dental and Medical Issues Consciousness, we tapped our health workers in the barangay including the Municipal nurses to educate our parents in order that the parents can educate also our learners.
- 7. Project MAPP- in having Mass Active Participation of parents in all Programs /Projects of the School during the time of implementation of Physical Development Projects we were able to inform them ahead of time and post notices to places where it can be seen by everyone and we also inform through our Group Chat.
- 8. Project ISUS PAD-to Initiate Stakeholders to Uphold School Projects and Activities for Continuous Development-all projects/programs were discussed with the SGC and PTA and agreed on how and when to implement.
- 9. Project HELE-having Happy Environment for Learners and Educators we tapped our stakeholders to beautify our school. For the Learners to have happy environment we address bullying by promoting anti-bullying
- 10. Project HUGAS -Healthiness is Useful in Governing all Activities in School through the construction of washing trough and portable washing area per classroom
- 11. Developing Proper Health Sanitation through Improvement of Comfort Rooms w/ Lavatories
- 12. Digging and Concreting of Drainage Canal to avoid flooding and muddy corridors and classroom doors to prevent accident due to slippery during rainy days
- 13. Project ISLA-Improvement of School Landscape Areas
- 14. Project GREEN in having Green Resources in Environment that Enhance Nutrition through Gulayan sa bakuran and planted flowers to beautify the school
- 15. Installation of water system especially to all classroom to have water
- 16. Repair and maintenance of furniture's and fixtures for the display of learners materials and filing necessary data in magazine boxes
- 17. Project LABOR -Lack of Amount for Basic Operation of Resources we were able to source out money through resolutions and donations of stakeholders. Parents render free labor especially during Brigada Eskwela

During home visitation we the teachers monitored the implementation of our projects and let the parents filled-out feedback forms in order for us to see suggestions for improvements but for the projects implemented in school still M&E forms were given and filled out by the participants.
