Senior Minister of Education

Dr Radzi Jidin is the Senior Minister of Education in the Malaysian government and a Senator in the *Dewan Negara* (Upper House of the Malaysian Parliament). As one of the four Senior Ministers in the Cabinet, he leads the Social Cluster, a group of eight ministries managing education and social policies. He served as Deputy Minister of Economic Affairs from July 2018 until February 2020.

Dr Radzi is the Information Chief of *Parti Pribumi Bersatu Malaysia* (BERSATU), one of the component parties in the ruling coalition. He is also the Deputy Chairman for *Institut Masa Depan Malaysia* (MASA), a think tank focusing on developing socioeconomic analysis.

Prior to joining politics, Dr Radzi was in academia where he taught undergraduate and postgraduate students at The Australian National University, the University of New South Wales and the University of Tasmania. His teaching and research interests covered financial accounting and reporting, corporate governance, ethics, and auditing, including forensic auditing. Dr Radzi regularly presented at international accounting conferences and published several papers in international accounting journals.

Dr Radzi obtained his PhD from The Australian National University.
